Workshop on "Redefining Learning and Question Paper Framing".

Aiming to provide an intense training to the teachers on how to provide quality education to the new generation students in this highly technological world, DPS Gaya organised a workshop on 1st December, 2018, on the topic "Redefining Learning and Question Paper Framing". The resource person of the workshop, Mr. G Balasubramaniam (the Ex-Director of C.B.S.E-Academics) was graciously invited by the Principal Mr. Sanjeet Soni. The workshop started with an enlightening introductory session in which the resource person highlighted the importance of body language of a teacher while teaching by citing several real life experiences. Discussing further about the academic issues and challenges, he stated the importance of providing Emotionally Competent Stimuli to the students and encouraging them to think, rather than dictating them what to do and curbing their individuality. Further dealing with the topic he reiterated, "Curriculum and text books are like runways for an aircraft to take off" and urged the teachers to bring creativity in their teaching. The later half of the workshop provided a brief idea about the important parameters which needed to be followed while designing a question paper. A special focus was made on the importance of vocabulary, syntax and stimulus words in a question paper as it reflects the profile of a school. The workshop was well appreciated by all the participants who expressed their satisfaction and admitted that the discussion was extremely useful for them.
